Project summary: Cooperation between USAID/PPMG and its partners – local self-government units – fosters an environment conducive to establishing and improving institutional mechanisms for supporting businesses owned by marginalized women.

Very early in her life, Aila faced one of the most difficult challenges in life. Life cast her in the role of a single mom, and she decided to play it to perfection. She decided to approach motherhood as a challenge, and now her 10-year-old son is her motivation and inspiration for all her accomplishments, present and future. Her son was her motivation to enter the world of entrepreneurship, to do more in her small town – Tešanj. Ajla didn't have a job, and needed to provide for herself and her son.

The inspiration for her business came from a movie, but she only had an idea. Without a iob and without money, she had no way to make it a reality, but she kept searching for a solution. She needed help with making her first steps, and wasn't too worried about what would come later. She had faith in her will, dedication and hard work bringing the results that she wanted.

"And the stars aligned." says Ajla, smiling.

USAID's Fund for Supporting Businesses Owned By Marginalized Women and the Municipality Tešani helped Aila get started. She received funds to launch her business, and Aila knew what she wanted and needed to do. She because the proud owner of the Event Agency JOY. Aila now brings joy to many families, make childhoods better, Tešanj more lively and the life of her son and her easier and more secure.

She used the money she received from the Fund and the Municipality to start her own business, buy the necessary equipment and embark on an adventure of making dreams come true. Ajla organizes theme birthday parties for children, educational workshops and courses, because she wants to make their childhood better, and for her older clients, she makes important moments unforgettable.

"I do everything that's beautiful. I organize birthday parties, business parties, opening ceremonies. The youngest ones are always in focus, because it bring them the most joy. For them I organized gift giving events and costume parties. I'm happy because my dreams came true, and now I can do the same for others. I'm happy that I'm doing what I love and that I have the support of my fellow citizens." - says Ajla, who uses every moment to come up with even better offers for her little happines factory – JOY Event Agency.

Ajla's agency organizes birthday parties, business parties, family days, and makes other people's beginnings happier.
